Parent-teacher meetings



Pollution action protocol

We would like to draw the attention of new families to the LFIB Pollution Action Plan.

In the event of a pollution peak, this plan is activated and has immediate consequences for your children's school life: indoor recess, outdoor recess for pupils wearing masks, cancellation of outdoor sports sessions. etc.

It is essential that each pupil has PM 2.5 pollution masks in his or her bag (a model of your choice; LFIB does not provide masks for pupils) from now on so that they can continue to play outside with masks if the threshold allows.
