#### <u>Parent-teacher meetings</u>

Parent-teacher meetings for classes MS to CM2 will be held **from Monday 18th November to Thursday 21st November inclusive**, depending on the availability of the teachers (class teacher, English teacher, reinforced Thai teacher, FLE teacher). They take place exclusively at the school (no Google Meet). Each interview lasts 20 minutes in maternelle and 15 minutes in elementary.

The pdf files give you an overview of the availability of your child's teachers, so that you can try to group the appointments into one visit to the school. You can register via the We Join In link for each teacher from Wednesday 6th November to Thursday 14th November. When you come for your appointment, you must sign the attendance sheet at reception.

Some additional information:

- appointments for Thai are reserved for reinforced Thai students
- appointments with the language teacher in Maternelle are made with the teacher of the language the child is learning (no appointment for the language discovered in bain de langue)

#### <u>Loy Krathong</u>



#### Presentation of the school canteen

**On Thursday 14th November,** we are inviting parents to a presentation and discussion on school canteen services, followed by a tour of the canteen where you can taste the dishes served to pupils that lunchtime.

#### **Pollution action protocol**

We would like to draw the attention of new families to the LFIB Pollution Action Plan.

In the event of a pollution peak, this plan is activated and has immediate consequences for your children's school life: indoor recess, outdoor recess for pupils wearing masks, cancellation of outdoor sports sessions, etc.

It is essential that each pupil has PM 2.5 pollution masks in his or her bag (a model of your choice; LFIB does not provide masks for pupils) from November so that they can continue to play outside with masks if the threshold allows.
