Pollution action protocol

At the moment, pollution levels are often high in the mornings. Therefore, in the event of a pollution peak, a specific plan is activated and immediate consequences children's school life:

- Indoor recess,
- · Outdoor recess only for students wearing
- Cancellation of outdoor sports activities,

It is therefore essential that each student has PM 2.5 anti-pollution masks (model of your choice, as LFIB does not provide masks to students) in their bag. This will allow them to continue playing outside with a mask if pollution levels permit.
