Back to school 2025

The first day of school is Tuesday 2nd September, at 7:55 a.m. for maternelle and 8:00 a.m. for primary school.

If you are taking your child to school for his/her first day, you may accompany him/her to the primary school playground before the bell rings, or to the front of the maternelle classroom (NB: a special welcome is planned for Petite Section pupils).

This year, we will have a mixed-level class in maternelle: the PS-MS class. In primary school, there will be two mixed-level classes: one CP-CE1 class and one CM1-CM2 class.

The timetable for CE2 classes will follow that of CM1 and CM2 classes, namely: a morning break from 10:00 to 10:20 and a lunch break from 11:30 to 12:50.
