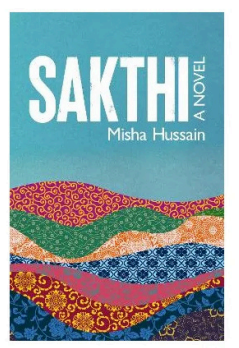
DNB Award Ceremony
