Since October, LFIB CE2 and CM2 students have been enthusiastically taking part in Le Prix des Incorruptibles, a children’s literary award. Their mission: read a selection of books and vote for their favourite!

To support them, the BCD offers a range of engaging activities: reading journals, comprehension quizzes, online competitions... and, above all, a highly anticipated illustration contest.

Organised in March–April, this optional individual competition invites students to illustrate an excerpt from a book using the technique of their choice. Their creations are then sent to France, where a jury of authors and illustrators rewards the most original and relevant works.

The results will be announced in June on the Incorruptibles website. Prizes include books and other lovely rewards!
