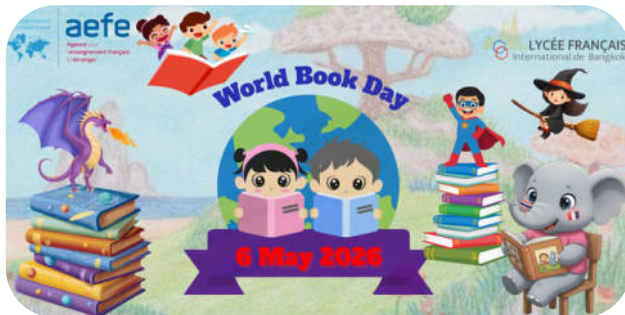

### World Book Day
