CLASS LISTS

Class lists are made available to families the day before the start of the new school year, to allow any final changes to be made following enrolment during the summer. 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BACK TO SCHOOL 2026

The first day of school is Wednesday 2nd September, at 7:55 a.m. for maternelle and 8:00 a.m. for primary school.

If you are taking your child to school for his/her first day, you may accompany him/her to the primary school playground before the bell rings, or to the front of the maternelle classroom (NB: a special welcome is planned for Petite Section pupils).

This year, we will have two mixed-level classes in maternelle: the PS/MS class and the MS/GS class.

In primary school, there will be two mixed-level classes: one CE1/CE2 class and one CM1/CM2 class.

The timetable for CE2 classes will follow that of CP and CE1 classes, namely: a morning break from 09:45 to 10:00 and a lunch break from 11:00 to 12:25.

In maternelle, all four classes will have morning break together from 10:00 to 10:30 a.m., followed by their lunch break starting at 11:30 a.m.

LANGUAGE LESSONS

Language lessons (Thai and English) start progressively during the first week of the school year to allow teachers to assess new pupils individually.

Please note that the afternoon Thai lessons will start on Wednesday 2nd September.

- CP and CE1: exit at 15:10 on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays
- CE2, CM1 and CM2: pupils leave at 16.10 on Tuesdays and 15.10 on Thursdays.
